The judges of the 1873 Vienna Exhibition exclaimed of Bendigo's early Hermitage, "No colonial wine could be that good!"

Through enterprise and hard work, Bendigo's new wave of winemakers have placed this region at the forefront of winemaking excellence today, with award-winning Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon wines.

The region's friendly, personal character is winning attention, too. The majority of Bendigo's wineries are small to medium-sized, and are still run by the families who founded them. Regular visitors to the region fondly refer to it as "The Winemakers' Region", knowing it is not uncommon to meet the winemakers, sleeves rolled up, tending vines or working in the winery.
